

The map shows the layout of the fort and its neighboring town. A planned extension (Bourg Projette) appears to the east of the town. Inland are some fields and sparse vegetation. The map includes a decorative title cartouche and rhumb lines.

This is one of the maps produced by Nicholas Bellin for his *Petit Atlas Maritime*. Bellin was one of the most important maritime cartographers in 18th-century France and was responsible for producing maps for the French Navy.
