Jansson's map is based upon Magini's map of 1620, which appeared in his atlas of Italy, the first modern atlas to focus on Italy.

Oriented with east at top, this fine map shows the Istria peninsula, Gulf of Treiste and the nearby islands. Inland is a huge Czirnicser See (Lake Cerknica), which does not appear on Blaeu's map of the same title. This is an intermittent lake that can be completely dry for years. But when full, it is the largest lake in Slovenia.

As a part of the Venetian Republic, this region contained many important sea ports that are highlighted on the map.
